

Certificates that are accepted as proof of English language competence for the full time Master Degree Program "Sports, Culture & Events Management" at the University of Applied Sciences Kufstein

Applicants for whom English is not their first language need to submit evidence that their English language proficiency meets the degree requirements (i.e. CEFR level C1) until the first day of studying.

The University accepts the following internationally recognized English language certificates as evidence of applicants' competence in the English language:

- **International English Language Testing System (IELTS):**
Overall grade of 6.5
- **TOEFL Internet-based Test (iBT):**
A minimum of 90 points overall
- **Cambridge English exams:**
 - Cambridge English Proficiency (CPE): Grade C or above
 - Cambridge English Advanced (CAE): Grade C or above
 - Cambridge English First (FCE): Grade A only
 - Cambridge Business English Higher (BEC): Grade C or above
- **Pearson Test of English (PTE):**
Academic - A score of minimum 67 points
- **LanguageCert Level 2:**
Certificate in ESOL International (Listening, Reading, Writing) - Expert C1

The scores achieved by applicants on any of the above-mentioned tests must demonstrate that they have reached the CEFR level C1.

If applicants don't have one of the above mentioned language certificates they can:

- submit a **letter from University** confirming their language competence at level C1.
OR
- take part in the **English Language Skills Test** (24€) on the day of admission at the University of Applied Sciences Kufstein. This computer based test takes about 40 minutes and consists of reading-, grammar- and vocabulary comprehension. The ELST is only valid for admission at the University of Applied Sciences Kufstein.
